Clean and Safe Teams Coordinate with LA Sanitation on Community Cleanup of Bulky Items

From discarded mattresses and other furnishings to wooden pallets and household appliances, our district is awash in bulky item trash. We've all seen how our streets, sidewalks and alleys can suddenly - or chronically - become cluttered with unwanted objects.

The VB BID has made picking up bulky trash items a very high priority, but our capacity to dispose of these items is limited. However, LA Sanitation has stepped up to help us out!
